#### DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

**From I-90 (Mass Pike) and points south:** Take I-495 North toward Lowell. Take exit 29B to MA-2 West toward Leominster 4.1 miles. Take exit 38B to MA-110 East/MA-111 North/Ayer Road toward Ayer/Groton. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto MA-111 North/Harvard Road heading to Ayer/Groton 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Groton-Harvard Road 1.1 miles. Slight right onto Washington Street 0.5 miles. Continue onto Groton Road, the field is on your right across from the hospital. It's a dirt road with a red barn.

## ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Eligible dogs must be one year of age or older and either individually registered with AKC, recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, or that have been granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP). (Complete eligibility rules can be found in the AKC Regulations for Lure Coursing Tests and Trials.) AKC recognized breeds: Purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughi, and Whippets. FSS breeds (may compete for suffix titles only): Norrbottenspets, Portuguese Podengos (Medio & Grande), Thai Ridgebacks, and Peruvian Inca Orchids. Dogs with AKC Limited Registration, Conditional Registration, or spayed and neutered hounds are eligible. Hounds may not be entered as "registration pending" or "ILP pending". Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are not eligible to participate. Breed disqualifications apply.

## STAKES OFFERED

**JUNIOR COURSER and QUALIFIED COURSER TESTS:** These tests are open to hounds at least 12 months of age. The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.

**OPEN STAKE:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or an ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a

Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC.

**SPECIALS STAKE:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship title. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles.

**VETERAN STAKE:** Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Specials stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, Whippets = 7 years, Rhodesian Ridgebacks = 7 years, Salukis = 7 years, Afghan Hounds = 7 years, and Ibizan Hounds = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

**SINGLES STAKE:** Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event. Order of running shall be determined by random draw. Each hound shall run the course alone. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake. Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/ or Best in Field courses.


## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial ● All Hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified. ● Bitches in season and lame hounds at time of Roll Call will be excused ● Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period ● Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications ● Battery or gasoline powered, continuous loop or drag lure machines will be used ● The lure will consist of plastic bags or strips ● Backup equipment will be available ● The course will be reversed for the final courses ● The members of GONE reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial ● There will be a \$5 fine for any hound loose on the field during another hound's course and for participants not cleaning up after their hounds ● Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the field committee and may be disciplined by the AKC ● Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times ● Early acceptance for roll call of hounds for members of the Field Committee may begin one-half hour prior to published trial/test hours.


## THINGS TO KNOW
